


SHADE TREES



STANDARD PRUNING

- Remove dead branches 1/2" diameter or larger.
- · Remove interfering, crossing, or dangerous branches.
- · Remove all old stubs.
- · Remove Broken and hanging branches.
- . Thin interior branches by one-third.
- · Clear from sidewalk or street.
- Remove lower branches to provide more space under tree, only if requested.
- · Shape to natural form.



STANDARD PRUNING THIN LIGHTLY

· Same as "Standard Pruning" except thin interior branches by one-fourth.

CUSTOM PRUNING

· Prune just what is stated on work order - nothing more, nothing less.

SPRUCE & PINES -



PRUNE OVERALL

- · Cut back to create a conical shape.
- Remove deadwood 1/2" and larger inside lower one-third of tree.



STANDARD PRUNING

· Same as "Prune Overall," but no deadwood removed.



SHEARING

· Formal shearing with electric shears to create the basic shape. No deadwood removed.

GLOSSARY-

PRUNING: Informal, selective cutting of branches with hand or power tools to maintain natural shape.

SHEARING: Trimming of branches with electric shears to achieve a smooth, formal, and symmetrical appearance.

CLEAR: Process of cutting back branches just far enough to clear sidewalks, street, patio, etc., and meet city code where necessary.

RAISE: Process of cutting back lowest branches to obtain more space beneath tree. Height to raise specified by customer.

REMOVE: Cutting tree down to stump, then digging out or otherwise removing stump and some roots.

- EVERGREENS —



PRUNE HARD

· Cut back as much as possible to control size and shape. Will cause a somewhat woody appearance.



PRUNE

· Cut back only to shape and control size.



PRUNE LIGHTLY

· Tip back extra long ends only. Done to new plants to encourage thicker growth.



SHEAR HARD

· Shearing with electric shears. May show some browning.



SHEAR

· Shearing back one or two years' growth to obtain formal shape.



SHEAR LIGHTLY

· Shear ends back with minimum reduction in size.



CUSTOM SHEARING/PRUNING

· Pruning or shearing just what is stated on work order — nothing more, nothing less.

DECIDUOUS - SHRUBS -



PRONE HARD

- · Remove one-third of the oldest canes at ground level.
- · Cut height and width back to size specified by customer.
- · Remove majority of deadwood.



PRUNE

- · Remove two or three of the oldest canes at ground level.
- · Cut back one foot, or as needed to shape.
- · Remove majority of deadwood.



PRUNE LIGHTLY

- Cut back extra long ends only.
- Remove only minimum amount of deadwood.





SHEARING

- · Use electric shears to shape. Reduce height and width as specified on work order.
- · No deadwood removed.







CUSTOM SHEARING/PRUNING

· Pruning or shearing just what is stated on work order — nothing more, nothing less.
